- Thursday 29th February: Entries will be accepted from 6.30am to 9am. (Pavilion closed from 9 am)
- Friday 1st March: Opens @ 10 am 8.00 pm
- Saturday 2nd March: Opens @ 8.30 am 7.00pm
- Sunday 3rd March: Open 9 am 11am sharp (for collection of Exhibits)

- 3. Entry Forms are available online at www.armidaleshow.org.au or the printed Schedule
- 4. NO PAVILION EXHIBITS ARE TO BE DELIEVERED TO THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE
- 5. PLEASE PRINT CLASS TICKETS TO SUBMIT WITH ENTRIES
- 6. Unless otherwise stated **NO** Exhibits will be accepted after 9am on Thursday
- 7. Entrants understand and agree to abide by the rules and conditions as outlined by the Society for all entries submitted for judging at the annual Agricultural Show
- 8. The relevant authority has the final say on the appropriateness of an entry, and has the authority to remove an entry prior to the commencement of judging
- 9. Exhibits that have previously won a prize at an Armidale Show are not eligible to enter
- 10. Awarding of prizes will be at the discretion of the Judge
- 11. Place cards and Champion Sashes shall be awarded in all sections
- 12. Ribbons shall be awarded for ALL children's classes
- 13. ALL CARE IS TAKEN BUT THE SOCIETY TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE
- 14. A Junior exhibitor is one under the age of eighteen (18) years
- 15. A Novice is a person who has not won a prize in the particular Class/Section at an Armidale Show
- 16. AV means Any Variety, AOV means Any Other Variety, AC means Any Colour, AOC means Any Other Colour
- 17. No posthumous entries will be accepted for any pavilion Exhibits
- 18. Any complaint must be reported and recorded by following the procedure for complaints as outlined on our website
