Conditions of entry:

1. Entry Fee: 50c per entry

- 2. Ribbons, Prize Cards and Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place.
- 3. Articles must have been made within the last 12 months and be the sole work of the exhibitor.
- 4. Exhibits to be entered in the class corresponding with the age of the child when the exhibit was created.
- 5. All small articles, for example, jewelry must be attached to cardboard or suitable backing.
- 6. Painting where the primary medium is paint, watercolour etc.
- 7. Artwork in any other medium may be in any medium other than paint (e.g. pencil, ink, print, mixed media etc.).
- 8. **Soft craft** may be made from fabric, felt, paper, leather, wool, soft plastic etc.
- 9. Hard craft may be made from plaster, pottery, wood, hard plastic, metal, beads etc.
- 10. **Recycled or Upcycled materials** include transforming by-products, waste materials, useless, or unwanted products into new materials or products.
- 11. Group entries are welcomed. For group entries (e.g. where a teacher enters multiple students), please attach the child's name, age and group name to the back of each entry.
- 12. Entry tickets are to be attached to the front of all artworks and craft projects.
- 13. Exhibitors name to be attached to the **back** of each entry. Names are not to be visible from the front.
- 14. All works to be collected from the Main Pavilion between 9am and 11am Sunday after the show.
