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Please read General Conditions and Regulations for Pavilion Exhibits

1. Entry Fee: All classes \$2 per entry.
2. All exhibits to be delivered to the Main Pavilion by 10 am, Friday 5th March 2021
3. All exhibits to display name of exhibitor, address and phone number, on the back. No names to be displayed on the front.
4. Items for sale must have price clearly marked and neatly fixed to the front of the work. Selling commission is 20%.
5. Exhibits must be original work, not copied and the sole effort of the exhibitor. All works to have been executed in the past 12 months.
6. Exhibits mounted or framed must have secure means of hanging, or will not be accepted. Children's work may be presented on card.
7. Exhibitors must enter in their current age group.
8. All care will be taken with exhibits but no responsibility or liability will be accepted for loss, damage or theft.
9. All works to be collected from the Main Pavilion on Friday 5th March by 6 PM
