2022 Show Theme – Water: A Rural Lifesaver

Please read the general conditions and regulations for Pavilion Exhibits

1. Entries can be dropped off from 12PM on Wednesday 2nd March until 8 PM, but it is preferred that entries be dropped off before 9 AM on Thursday 3rd March, with Judging commences at 10:30am
2. Blooms must be grown by the exhibitor
3. The Show Society has jars available for the staging of blooms
4. Exhibitor to ensure that all stems of flowers and foliage are secure in the container and all entrants must be responsible for topping up the entry with water before leaving
5. Containers of blooms not to have any embellishments e.g. water pearls, ribbon, oasis etc.
6. Exhibitors in novice section must not have won a Champion at any show with the exception of under 18 exhibitors
7. Champion will only be awarded if there is more than 3 entries in the section with the exception of the under 6 & 12 yrs. Section
8. Enchanted Gardens must be exhibited on a board no bigger than 20cm x 20cm provided by the exhibitor.
9. **Natural embellishment** refers to things made by nature OTHER than flowers e.g stones, feathers, shells etc
10. **Artificial embellishment** refers to anything man made e.g. ribbon, figurines, painted or dried material
11. **Any embellishment** means that the exhibitor may use natural or artificial embellishment
12. **Free embellishment:** This is exhibitors' choice, no restriction with container, materials, height or embellishment, flowers used need not be grown by the exhibitor

Explanation of terms:

D: Distinct (this refers to staging unit and for the larger blooms; each bloom must be distinct from the others. For smaller blooms types it means that each vase is to contain (3) blooms of the (1) variety and each vase is to be a different variety

NND: Not necessarily distinct

AOV: All one variety

SPEC: Specimen meaning one

DAHLIA STANDARDS:

- Giant Decorative and Giant Cactus - over 260mm
- Large Decorative and Large Cactus - over 210mm & under 260mm
- Medium Decorative & Medium Garden cactus - Over 160mm & under 210mm
- Small Decorative and Garden Cactus - Over 120mm & under 160mm
- Miniature Decorative or Garden Cactus - over 90mm & under 120mm
- Medium Fimbriated Cactus - over 160mm and under 210mm
- Small Fimbriated Cactus - over 120mm & under 160mm
- Ball or show type Dahlia - over 90mm
- Ball or show type Dahlia - under 90mm
- Nymphae and collaret- both 1 size under 90mm over 160mm
- Pompon – 1 size under 50mm
- Container of dahlias minimum of 6 blooms & maximum of 12
- All dahlia blooms must have a stem of 300mm
- Blooms over/under size will be penalised but not disqualified
