* **Classes will be run if a minimum of 3 entries per class are submitted** (organisers will be in contact with exhibitors if classes are cancelled due to numbers).

- All animals must be Ovine Brucellosis, footrot and Johnes Disease free – National Sheep Health Declaration and NVD papers must be sighted prior to animals being unloaded.
- Sheep infested with lice or ked, diseased or ill will not be allowed on the grounds.
- All sheep are to be bred by the exhibitor.
- The exhibitor is to provide the necessary feed they deem appropriate for the duration of the animals attendance.
- Stewards will be in attendance to receive sheep from 4pm Friday 6th March 2020. At the conclusion of judging, sheep can begin to be packed up and removed. Following delivery, all vehicles (except those with membership in designated member parks) are to be removed from the Showgrounds.
