1. Submission of exhibits: Wednesday March 4th 2020 between 3pm - 6pm and also the morning of Thursday March 5th between 7.30am - 9am.
2. Judging will take place Thursday March 5th at **9am sharp, and no late exhibits will be accepted.**
3. All exhibitors must produce required quantity stated for each class. The stewards will reject all entries if this condition is not fulfilled
4. Exhibits are to be the bona fide production of the Exhibitor. Any exhibit found to be purchased, will be disqualified, along with all other exhibits from the exhibitor
5. Champion and Reserve Champion Farm Produce Exhibit
6. Potatoes to be displayed by exhibitors on stands of uniform commercial size and washed. Green leaf produce can be presented in vases
7. At the collection of produce, any exchange collections or allocation of produce between exhibitors and others must be notified to the Head Steward (in writing) so as to avoid any alleged misrepresentation and confusion
