- 2- Exhibits cannot be accepted on behalf of an exhibitor without their written and signed consent
- 3- Cleanliness is essential and work MUST NOT have been washed or worn

## HINTS AND TIPS FOR EXHIBITORS

- Tension is the basis of all designs
- If exhibiting a pair they should be identical
- Babies' or Children's sets to consist of garment PLUS Accessory
- Ensure babies garments are not tight and seams are flat
- Ensure ends are woven in on all articles
- Rugs: make sure corners are square and squares and medallions all the same size
- Articles should be blocked.

### **KNITTING or CROCHET**

13. Toy/Amigurumi and Doll Clothes
  14. Household Article (Pillow, Tea Cosy, Coat Hanger, Edged towel, Pillow or Tea Cosy)
  15. Knitting or Crochet not using needles or a hook (I.e. Arm knitting)
  16. Knitting and Crochet combined
  17. 100% natural fibre- Article must have yarn tags attached
  18. Stash Buster
  19. Other Article
- \*\*Champion Knitting or Crochet item (Classes 13-19)

### **OPEN**

20. Original Item – Not from a pattern. Originality of design important
  21. Creative - Any technique including sculptural or three-dimensional works
  22. Tunisian
  23. Macramé
  24. Accessory
  25. Tatting
  26. Article made with a loom (Hairpin lace, French Knitting etc)
  27. Fine Knitting or Crochet (Doily, Handkerchief with edge, Centrepiece, or Duchess Set)
  28. Any Article Group project (Minimum 2 people)

### **OVER 70 YEARS**

29. Knitted Article
  30. Crochet Article

### **NOVICE** - (Novice classes are open only to Exhibitors who have not previously entered)
