

Terms and Conditions - Logo Design Competition

1. This competition is for the design of a new logo for The Armidale & New England Show Society Inc (herein referred to as The Show Society).
2. The contest is open to residents of the Armidale Regional LGA.
3. If contestants are under the age of 18 on the closing date (see section 10 below), Parent/Guardian consent is required to enter this competition.
4. To enter the competition, design a logo to be used by The Show Society according to the design brief located on the Armidale Show website – <http://www.armidaleshow.org.au/the-armidale-show-logo-competition.html>. The winning logo may be used in all media – including online, print, on merchandise and other visual collateral.
5. All designs must be submitted by online form only. The online form is located on the Armidale Show website
6. By submitting a design to this competition, you are accepting these Terms and Conditions. You further agree that if your entry is selected as the winning entry, you are assigning your entire right title and interest in your design to The Show Society and you will not be entitled to receive any royalties or other consideration, now or in the future, for such assignment other than the contest prize set forth in Section 13 below. In such case, the Show Society will own your design and will have the exclusive right to use your design on a worldwide and exclusive basis in perpetuity, including the right to use the design for promotional purposes and any other use or purpose. If you are not selected as the winner, ownership of your design and all intellectual property rights in such design will revert to you. By submitting a design, you agree to these terms and conditions, but if your design is not the winning entry, this shall be null and void and of no effect.
7. Entries must be entirely your own original work and must not breach or be in violation of any copyright or other rights of third parties. The Show Society will not be in any way liable for any non-original work submitted by you and you agree to indemnify and hold the Armidale Show Society harmless from any such claim. All entries must be suitable for publication on the website and public viewing. The Armidale Show Society maintain the right to further develop your design to suit the 'Show' brand. The design must not include any defamatory, offensive or unlawful content.
8. If you wish to enter this competition, you must provide the Show Society with your full name, current residential address, telephone number and email address. The Show Society will only use your personal details for the purposes of administering this competition and, except your full name, will not publish such information or provide such information to anyone without your permission.
9. Multiple entries will be accepted per person. Entries cannot be returned so remember to keep a copy. Please also keep a higher resolution version of the entry. If selected as the winner, we may ask you to provide this copy.
10. The deadline for receiving entries for the competition by email is 5 PM Wednesday 13th September 2021. Results will be announced on the Show Society's Facebook page shortly thereafter. The Show Society reserves the right to extend the competition deadline at its discretion. If there is a revision, the revised date will be published on the website and the date for announcing the results will be postponed accordingly.
11. The Show Society reserves the right to use any subjective criteria it chooses in selecting a winner.
12. The Show Society's decision is final and binding.

13. The winner will receive a prize pack including membership for 2 years of the Armidale & New England Show Society, and vouchers as well as acknowledgement at the Grand Opening for the 2022 Armidale Show.
14. The prize must be taken in voucher form and cannot be deferred or transferred.
15. The Show Society does not accept any responsibility for late or lost entries regardless of the reason. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
16. Entrants must supply full details as required above, and comply with all rules to be eligible for the prize. No responsibility is accepted for ineligible entries or entries made fraudulently. Proof of age or eligibility may be required.
17. The contest may be cancelled at the sole discretion of the Show Society for any reason and at any time. Furthermore, the Show Society reserves the right to change or modify any of the rules or procedures for any reason and at any time.
18. Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these rules and to agree to be bound by them when entering this competition.
