## Conditions of Entry

- All competition at this Show is governed by the Regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections
- The Armidale & New England Show Society abides by E.A Rules

## Drug Testing

- This Show is a Member of the Central Northern Group of Show Societies and this Group has undertaken a horse drug testing program that was implemented from the commencement of Group Shows in 1991
- Drug Testing at this Show works under ASC Guidelines.
- **It is your responsibility to know the Rules and Regulations regarding this drug testing program, and this Show or this Group will not, in any way, accept responsibility for your lack of knowledge and/or understanding of this subject**

## Wristbands, Waivers and Bio-Security

- Each competitor **MUST**, before competing, complete and sign a Participant Risk Acknowledgement and Waiver Form, indemnifying the Armidale and New England Show Society Inc, and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitors' property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show
- Any Competitor under the age of 18 years of age, needs their waiver signed by a Parent or Guardian
- Wrist Bands will be issued upon signing. Wristbands **MUST** be worn by all exhibitors in the Horse Section **at all times** whilst competing at this Show
- All competitors **MUST**, before competing, complete and sign a Horse Health Declaration, and lodge with the Show Secretary. Forms can be found on the website, or at the Secretary's Office

# General Conditions

1. Riders and Handlers **MUST** sign Indemnity Waivers before competing
2. PIC Numbers need to be recorded with either the Ring Office or the Secretaries Office
3. All riders must wear an approved safety helmet while riding and competing on the Showground
4. All horses ages to be calculated from August 1<sup>st</sup>
5. Judges should present 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places (if worthy).
6. Prize money will only be awarded in Classes with more than one (1) entry.
7. Prizemoney will be awarded to Champion and Supreme Champion recipients. All prizemoney is to be collected from the Ring Office before completion of the show, or else will be forfeited to the Show Society.
8. The Judge's decision is final. All exhibitors are asked to refrain from seeking performance feedback until Judging of that class is completed
9. No exhibits in general ring events are to appear in the ring to be judged with any prize ribbons on, or with any distinguishing badge
10. A **Pony** is not exceeding 14 hh. A **Galloway** is over 14hh and not exceeding 15 hh. **Hack** is over 15 hh.
11. All Breeds and Classifications must be registered with their relevant Breed Association/Society and all riders/handlers must be financial members of the respective Breed Society. Registration and Membership papers must be available on request
12. No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ring Master or Chief Steward
13. A **Maiden** is a Hack that has not won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize in a Hack Class
14. A **Novice Hack** is open to horses that have never won an Open Champion at a recognised Show
15. An **Intermediate Hack** is open to horses that have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize as a Hack at a Royal Show, in either Hack or Hunter classes
16. Competitors **MUST** choose if their horse is **EITHER HUNTER OR HACK**. Horses may not compete in both
17. Competitors **MUST** choose if their horse is either Adults or Childs Hack. They may not compete in both
18. If, in the opinion of the Ringmaster or the Steward, any animal is entered in the wrong class, the Ringmaster or Steward, shall have the power to enter the animal in its correct class prior to the commencement of the Judging of the class
19. Only Judges, Stewards and Competitors in the class being judged will be allowed in the Ring
20. A Parent/Parents **SHALL NOT** enter the Show Ring whilst the Competitor is competing in any event **UNLESS** so authorised by the Ringmaster
21. Competitors in each class must report to the Judge within three (3) minutes of the final call for that class
22. In Champion events, the horse must be ridden by the same rider who rode it to win in that class
23. Stallions must be led by a bar, chain or bit when required. **HANDLERS MUST BE 17 YEARS AND OVER.** No Stallions may compete in Hack or Hunter classes
24. **Local Classes:** Horses must be owned and permanently stabled within **20 kms** of Armidale and ridden by a local resident. Boarding School students in Armidale may ride in District Classes if both horse and rider reside in the local district. They must choose to either ride in their home town district or as an Armidale district rider.
25. No alcohol is permitted in the Main Ring
26. No mobile phones permitted in the Main Ring by competitors
27. All protests must be delivered to the Ringmaster in writing within half an hour after an award has been made, with a \$50.00 lodgement fee. Any protest will be assessed by two (2) members of the Show Society Committee, and the ruling will be final
28. **While every effort will be made to follow the program, the Stewards reserve the right to change the Schedule of Events**
