Merino Section

- 1- **Fleeces must be delivered to the Pavilion between 8 am and 11 am on Monday 26th February. Judging held on Tuesday 27th February**
- 2- All fleeces must be delivered in **clean** plastic bags, **one** fleece per bag, with name and **Class Number clearly marked.**
- 3- Fleeces must be skirted for market, the product of one sheep and grown by the Exhibitor in the last growing season (previous 12 months). Judges will make allowances for wool deemed to be overgrown via trueness of types/weight. Sheep must be unhusked.
- 4- Hogget wool to be unshorn and is not eligible for Grand Champion.
- 5- Rams and Pairs of Fleeces are not eligible for Grand Champion.
- 6- Novice Section is open to all exhibitors who have not won a Champion Ribbon.
- 7- Highest Point Score to receive Champion Ribbon.
- 8- Most Successful Exhibitor awarded on the following scale of points: 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 1 point for 3rd and 1.5 points for Champion.
- 9- Fleeces must be collected on Sunday 3rd March between 9am and 12pm. Unclaimed Fleeces become the property of the Society.
- 10- Tender/unsound fleeces will not be accepted.

Other Commercial Fibres (I.e. Alpaca, Goat (doe or wether), Rabbit, Camel etc)

- 12- Fibre must be in **clean** plastic bags, **one** fibre per bag, with name and **Class Number clearly marked.**
- 13- Fibre must be skirted for market, the product of one animal and grown by the Exhibitor in the last growing season. (previous 12 months). Judges will make allowances for wool deemed to be overgrown via trueness of types/weight. Sheep must be unhusked.
- 16- Points awarded for commercial requirements.
- 11- Fibre must be collected on Sunday 3rd March between 9am and 12pm. Unclaimed Fleeces become the property of the Society.
- 17- Tender/unsound fibres will not be accepted.
