1. Submission of exhibits: Wednesday 5th March between 3pm - 6pm and the morning of Thursday 6th March between 7.30am - 9am.
2. Judging will take place Thursday March 6th at **9am sharp, and no late exhibits will be accepted.**
3. All exhibitors must produce required quantity stated for each class. The stewards will reject all entries if this condition is not fulfilled
4. Exhibits are to be the bona fide production of the Exhibitor. Any exhibit found to be purchased, will be disqualified, along with all other exhibits from the exhibitor
5. Champion and Reserve Champion Farm Produce Exhibit will be awarded
6. Potatoes to be displayed by exhibitors on stands of uniform commercial size and washed.
7. Green leafy produce can be presented in vases
8. Scarecrows can be any size, but needs to be manageable and able to be shifted around for judging and display purposes. **THEY MUST BE ABLE TO STAND FREELY**
9. At the collection of produce, any exchange collections or allocation of produce between exhibitors and others must be notified to the Head Steward (in writing) so as to avoid any alleged misrepresentation and confusion
