4. If the Exhibitor would like to enter in other sections, there is an entry fee of 2.00 per entry. All entries must have the name of the Exhibitor, and which class they are entering, on their Entry forms. Also, if possible, please mark the entries with the Exhibitor’s name on the back.
5. Wall Hangings are to be no larger than 80cm x 60cm
