Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor, crafted within the last 12 months and not previously worn.

Please note: **Key** definitions of Article\*, Garment\* and Accessory\* below.

## **Spinning** (include sample of raw wool/fibre)

1. Min 25g Skein of Fine Handspun Wool equivalent to 2 ply eg. suitable for baby garment or shawl
2. Min 50g Skein of Handspun Wool equivalent to 5 ply - indicate intended use
3. Min 50g Skein of Handspun Wool equivalent to 8 ply - indicate intended use
4. Min 50g Skein of Handspun Blended Fibre - label identifying fibre used & intended use
5. Min 25g Skein of Handspun Yarn, other than wool - indicate intended use
6. Min 50g Skein of Chunky/Art Yarn any fibre - indicate intended use

**\*\*Best in Classes 1-6**

## **Junior** (aged under 18)

17. Min 25g Skein of Handspun - any fibre, include a sample of raw fibre
18. Article\*, Accessory\* or Garment\* made from Handspun any fibre, any technique, include sample of yarn
19. Woven Article\*, Accessory\* or Garment\*
20. Felted Article\*
21. Felted Garment\* or Accessory\*

**\*\* Best in Classes 17-21**

## **Dyeing**

22. Collection of 4 or more vegetable-dyed fibres – Min 10gm Skein each – Note source dyes and mordant used.
23. Collection of 4 or more commercial-dyed fibres – Min 10g Skein each. - Note source dyes
24. Hand-dyed Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\* using commercial dyes. - Note source dyes & incl yarn sample
25. Hand-dyed Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\* using vegetable dyes. - Note source dyes and mordants used and include yarn sample

**\*\* Best in Classes 22-25**

## **Weaving**

7. Hand-woven length of fabric, not less than 1 (one) metre in length - indicate intended use
8. Hand-woven Garment\*
9. Hand-woven Accessory\*
10. Hand-woven Article\*

**\*\* Best in Classes 7-10**

## **Felting**

26. Hand Felted Article\*
27. Hand Felted Garment\* or Accessory\*
28. Knit, Crochet or woven to Felt - any Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\*
29. Needle Felted Bird or Animal
30. Needle Felted Embellishment on an Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\* - (not entered in any other class or section)

**\*\*Best in Classes 26-30**

## **Novice**

*(Anyone who has not previously won a prize in Section 8)*

11. Min 50g Skein of Handspun - any fibre. - Indicate intended use and include a sample of raw fibre
12. Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\* made from Handspun Wool - any fibre - any technique, include sample of yarn
13. Woven Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\*

**\*\* Best in Classes 11-13**

## **Open**

31. Article\* made from Handspun, include sample of yarn
32. Garment\* made from Handspun, include sample of yarn
33. Accessory\* made from Handspun, include sample of yarn
34. Any Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\*, any method, combination handspun and/or commercial yarns

**\*\*Best in Classes 31-34**

## **Schools**

14. Felted Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\*
15. Woven Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\*
16. Any Article\*, Garment\* or Accessory\*, any other method from Handspun, incl. sample of yarn

**\*\*Best in Classes 14-16**

## **Key**

- Article\*** (non-wearable item) eg. Vase, Pot, Placemat ,Tea/Hand Towel, Tea Cosy, Rug (floor, knee, pet, other), Cushion, Coat Hanger, Picture/Wall Hanging, Mobile, Toy, Glasses Case, Market Bag, Curtains, etc.
- Garment\*:** (wearable item) eg. Vest, Cardigan, Jumper, Coat, Skirt, Dress etc.
- Accessory\*:** (wearable item) eg. Shawl, Scarf, Hat, Gloves, Socks, Slippers, Shoulder bag, Jewellery, Purse, Belt, Tie, Brooch etc.
